PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

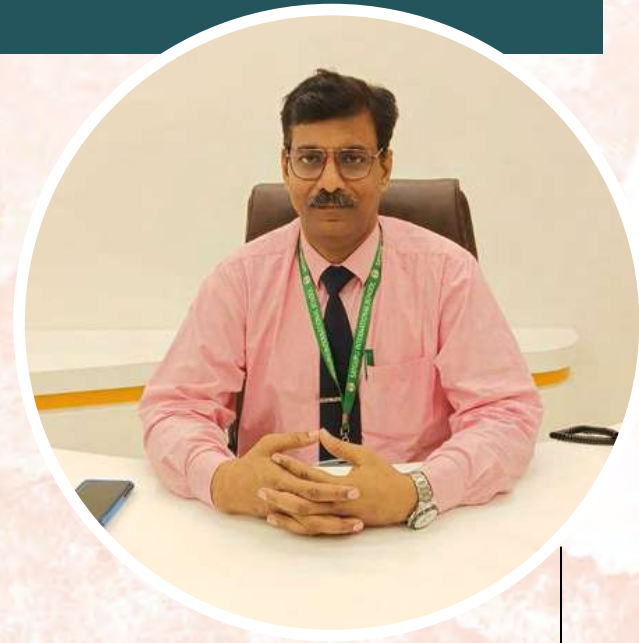
Dear Parents,
