Felicitation Ceremony for Class X Board Achievers (2025–26) was held on 23 April 2026.

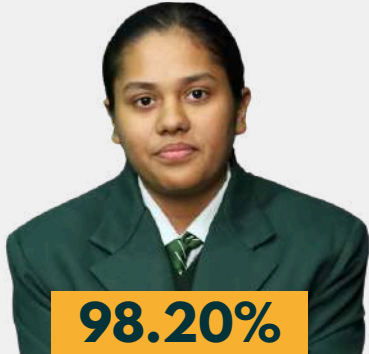
